

RSST Fair Share Program

RSST strives to provide a safe and enjoyable experience to all swimmers and families. It takes many people to make our practices and meets run smoothly and efficiently. In the past, we have asked that each family volunteer to help with at least one meet during the season. We have many families that volunteer on a regular basis, and we really appreciate your help! Even though we have many volunteers, year after year we struggle to find enough helpers. We often have to have board members and coaches fill in for these roles. This is pulling them away from other important jobs that are necessary for the meet to run. To address these needs, the RSST Board has decided to implement a Fair Share Program. This program will help ensure that everyone is doing their “Fair Share” to help us run successful meets.

How it works:

- At registration, each family will be asked to pay a \$10 fee.
- Each family will be asked to help at 1 meet during the season.
- After the family has met their 1 meet obligation, their \$10 will be returned to them.
- If a family chooses not to volunteer at 1 meet, they will not be refunded their money and the \$10 fee will be put in the RSST general fund.

There will be a sign up sheet located by the pool office during the season. If you have any questions about job descriptions, please don't hesitate to ask a coach or board member.
